



Registration Procedure

Before sending their applications, students need to get in touch with the **EELISA coordinator at their university**, in order to complete the **EELISA Learning Agreement** document to add their EELISA course to their diploma supplement.

- 1. In order to apply for a course, students have to send an email, sharing the following information:
 - Name
 - Date of Birth
 - E-Mail
 - Home university
 - Field and level of study at home university (BA, MA, PhD)
 - Name of the course(s) they want to attend
 - Proof of their language proficiency (if required by the course provider)
 - Official school records showing their GPA and year of enrollment
- 2. After the deadline, students receive an e-mail notice of the selection process (based on first come, first serve) and further information on how to participate in the course from the course provider.
- 3. Please follow the procedure below for application if you want the course to be added to your diploma supplement in your home institution:
 - Apply for the course at the host institution
 - Get an acceptance letter from the professor teaching the course
 - Submit the acceptance letter with your learning agreement to EELISA Department/Program Coordinator
 - Submit the approved learning agreement with required paperwork to respective Faculty/Institute
 - Get approval from Faculty/Institute Administrative Board
 - Have the acceptance letter approved by ITU Dean of Students
 - Follow host institution's registration guidelines
 - Get a certificate of attendance from the host institution and have the certificate approved by the Dean of Studies (or relevant unit) of the host institution at the completion of the term
 - Submit the approved certificate to EELISA Department/Program coordinator
 - The procedure for counting EELISA course for diploma supplement is executed by Student Registrar's Office with approval from EELISA Department/Program coordinator





Notes:

- In order to be able to follow the course student should furthermore check the prerequisites to attend the course as well as the language requirements.
- Some courses may require more information about you, so be mindful and check course website about registration procedures.
- Please note: the start dates of courses may not correspond with the start of the teaching period at your home institution.
- The system is first come, first served, but the lecturer and coordinator have the right to refuse students that do not meet the conditions.
- EELISA courses cannot be recognized as part of your degree programme, but your achievements will be shown in your diploma supplement as an EELISA course. Moreover, you will receive a certificate of completion and may be eligible for EELISA credentials.
